TABLE DECORATING INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

This is a fun opportunity to express yourselves and be creative! It is also an opportunity to guarantee that your group will sit together during the installation ceremony banquet. But most of all it is a way for you to be recognized for going the extra step to be a Child Nutrition Motivator!

- 1. You must use the table(s) reserved for you. Your name and parish will be on your table(s).
- 2. You must use the conference theme: Making Waves in School Nutrition
- 3. You must use the color scheme of Blue, Green and Orange.
- 4. Your space to decorate will be the center of a round banquet table, about 15-18" square.
- 5. DO NOT use any confetti or glitter spray as we will be charged an additional cleaning fee.
- 6. This year we will display the centerpieces on a table for everyone to enjoy and for judging before the banquet.
- 7. You will be informed about the location of the display table in an email before the conference.
- 8. The number of tables you can request to decorate is based on how many people will be in your group. The tables will be set up to seat 10. If you have 10 people you get one table. If you have 5 people, you get one table and have the pleasure of sharing the other 5 seats with fellow conference attendees.
